We look forward to seeing you at the Jam Packed UK event being held in Hamilton Grammar School.

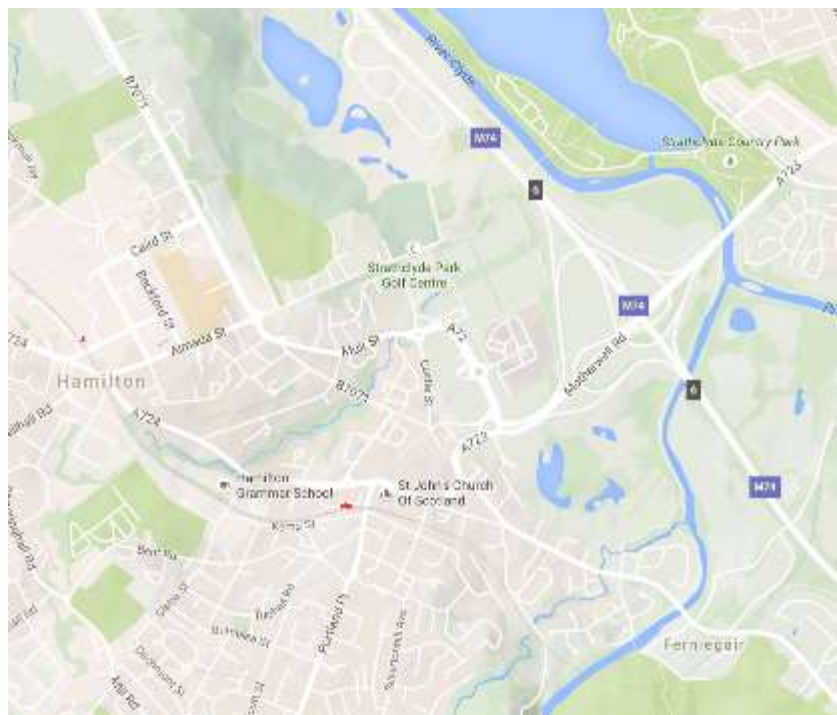
### How to find us:

Hamilton Grammar School is located in the town of Hamilton just off the M74 motorway. There are major roadworks happening at Junction 5, "The Raith interchange" so the town is best approached from Junction 6.

## **Hack to the Future...**

### **August 28<sup>th</sup> AM (During the school day)**

For 40 pupils in S2, there will be a chance to do a couple of getting started workshops on some of these computing contexts associated with the Raspberry Pi.

### **Hack to the Future Staff CPD - August 28<sup>th</sup> PM (1.30pm – 3.30pm)**

Two workshop sessions will be led for Teachers Primary or Secondary who are interested in getting started with the Raspberry Pi. These sessions will be appropriate to colleagues from a variety of backgrounds (e.g. Primary/Secondary, Computing, Science, Technical Education) as they look at using the Raspberry Pi in pedagogy and practice.

### **Family Hack Jam - August 28<sup>th</sup> Evening (6.30 – 9.30pm)**

The school will host a Family Hack event where members of the Jam Packed Team will run a Family Friendly night of computing based problem solving. Family members young and old are encouraged to come along together and take part in a series of challenges. Participants will have the opportunity to use a school computer (or bring their own laptop) whilst they work through the computing challenges.

### **Raspberry Jam - August 29<sup>th</sup> (10.30 am – 3.30 pm)**

This is a community event for all those who are interested in the Raspberry Pi. The event offers a chance for enthusiasts to come along and learn from others how the Raspberry Pi can be used in an in formal setting.

During the day there will be spaces for people to set up their own raspberry Pi and code in a community setting getting assistance from those around them.

Demonstrators can show their own projects and explain what they did for others to encompass as part of their own ideas.

Short Project Talks – the opportunity will exist to have guests come and do 30 minute talks about their projects, what they have done, problems experienced and how these were overcome.

### **Refreshments**

There will be a tuck shop for light refreshments however visitors are advised to bring a packed lunch as no catering will be provided.
